The Board will consider interested applicants from the following disciplines: **Agricultural** (Representing occupations or sufficient educational credentials related to commercial farm, forestry, fishery activities, agri-business, agri-sciences or agricultural research or education), **Environmental** (Representing occupations or sufficient educational credentials related to environmental professions which may include but are not limited to environmental sciences, environmental consultancy, natural area land management, environmental research or education, and environmental conservation/protection organizations or agencies), and **Professional** (Representing occupations or sufficient educational credentials related to regional environmental issues, banking, finance, land planning, surveying, law, engineering, education, surveying development and real estate or professional experience in geology, hydrology or geography).
