Procedures and Policy for VACATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY (F.S. 336.09 and 336.10)

STEP 1 – Initial Review

The following items must be submitted to the County Engineer and the Critical Infrastructure Director as part of the initial review. The cost of this review will be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), this is non-refundable. If the initial review is supported by the County Engineer and the Critical Infrastructure Director, those funds will be applied towards the total fee for the Right of Way.

- a. Written Petition (Form Attached)
- b. Aerial Map showing the property line and the right of way. 1" = 200' scale aerial photograph/tax map overlay (available at the County Property Appraisers Office located on the first floor of the Government Center)
- c. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) non-refundable fee

The County Engineer will issue a letter of determination (objection or no objection). A copy will be forwarded to the Petitioner or representative for their information. Based on the provided determination, the applicant has the opportunity to move forward to the secondary review at their own time and expense.

STEP 2 – Requirements for continuing petition

The following items must be submitted to the Engineering office once the Initial Review is completed by the County Engineer and the Critical Infrastructure Director.

- a. Resolution to set Public Hearing (Staff will provide)
- b. Notice of Public Hearing (Staff will provide)
- c. Resolution to Vacate (Staff will provide)
- d. Public Notice of Adoption of Resolution (Staff will provide)
- e. One (1) copy of the recorded plat with the petitioned area, or border shaded in red (Staff will provide).
- d. Letters from all utility companies in the affected area of the subject right-of-way. If any easements are requested by any utility or the County, a 30-year title search, with all documentations attached, on the properties affected will be required.
- e. A letter from the Highlands County Road & Bridge Director (4344 George Boulevard, Sebring, Florida 33872) approving, or disapproving the closing of subject right-of-way.

- f. The Petitioner shall attach a letter from the County Zoning Supervisor (501 South Commerce Avenue, Sebring, Florida 33870) stating “the closing of the petitioned right-of-way will not cause non-conforming use of any property.”
- g. The Petitioner must submit a list of all property owners within 200 feet of the proposed Right of Way to be closed. For the purpose of notification as described in **STEP 2**, an owner of property shall be deemed to be the person who, with his address, appears on the tax rolls of the County, at the time of the filling of the petition.
- h. Petition for vacation of right-of-way either in whole or in part must be accompanied by receipts showing that all State and County taxes have been paid.
- i. Processing fee as adopted by the Board, made payable to the Highlands County Board of County Commissioners.

STEP 3 – Resolution to set the Public Hearing

After the petition is received and the application deemed complete and reviewed by the County Engineer, the Resolution to set the Public Hearing Date will be submitted, by the County Engineer, to the Board of County Commissioners requesting a public hearing date to be set for the Board to consider the closing of the Right of Way. This request will be scheduled for the next possible agenda. After adoption of this Resolution, the Notice of Public Hearing will be mailed to the Petitioner for publication (see STEP 4). In addition to the publication, the Notice of Public Hearing must be sent out by the Petitioner, to all property owners within 200 feet of any proposed road to be closed, and shall be mailed “Certified, Return Receipt Requested” with the proof of receipt noting return to the County Engineer’s Office, 505 S. Commerce Avenue, Sebring Florida 33870-3869. The Petitioner shall be responsible for preparing the notices, addressing the envelopes, paying postage and mailing of the “Certified Notices.” For verification purposes, the following must be noted on the certified notice: “Petitioner: (name of Petitioner)”.

Notices must be mailed (post marked) at least two weeks prior to the Public Hearing date.

STEP 4 – Publish the Notice of Public Hearing

Petitioner shall publish the Notice of Public Hearing one time in the newspaper of general circulation in Highlands County at least **two weeks prior to the date stated therein for such hearing**. “Proof of Publication” must be received in the County Engineer’s office prior to the public hearing date. **The Petitioner, or a representative, may attend the Board meeting, to explain why**

the petition is necessary, when the public hearing is held.

STEP 5 – Posting of Signs on both ends of right-of-way

The County will post the required signage at both ends of the right-of-way to be vacated.

STEP 6 – What to do after the Public Hearing

After the public hearing is held if the Resolution to Vacate has been adopted by the Board, the Petitioner must advertise the Public Notice of Adoption of Resolution one time in a newspaper of general circulation published in Highlands County within thirty (30) days following the adoption of the resolution, and proof of this publication shall be sent to the County Engineer's Office, 505 S. Commerce Avenue, Sebring, Florida 33870-3869.

STEP 7 – After your newspaper ad runs

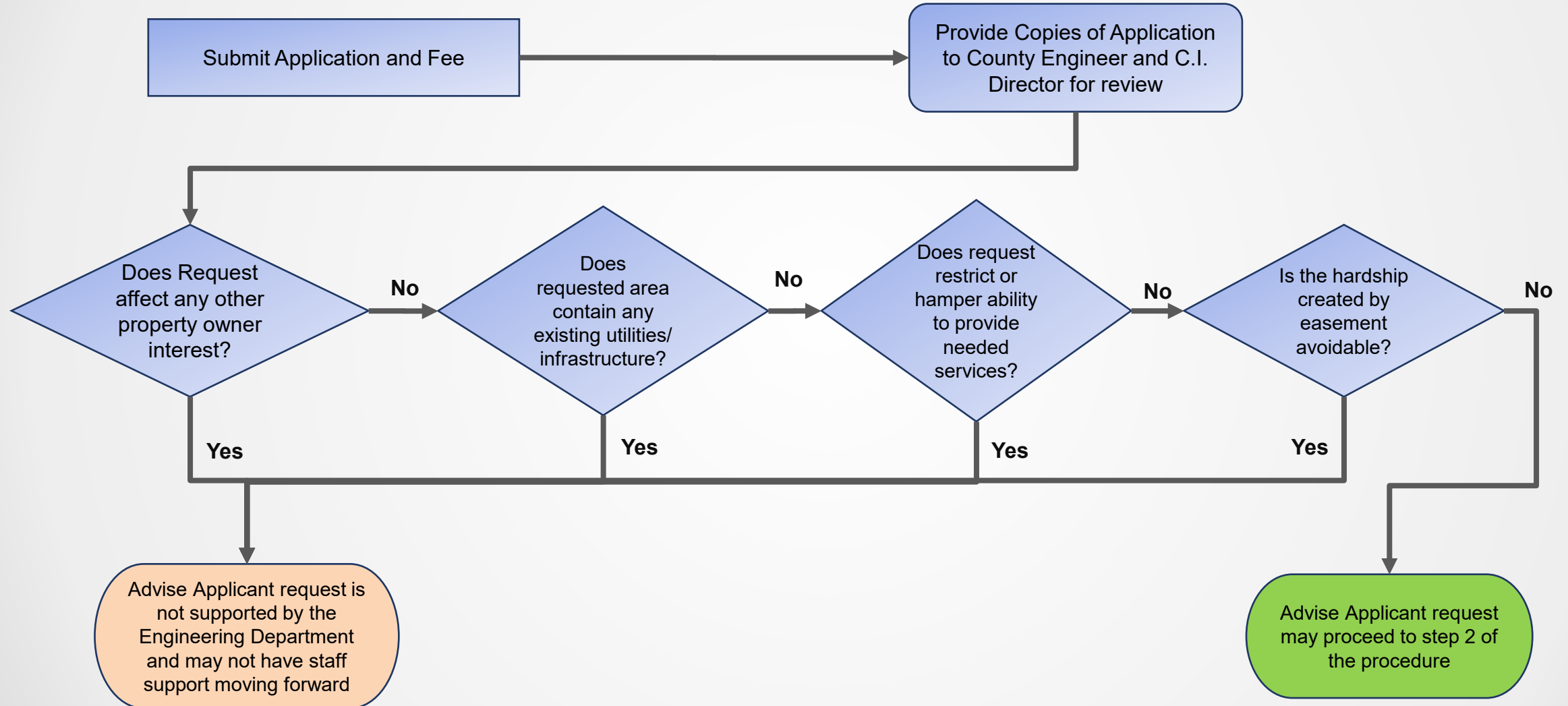
The County Engineering Department shall forward the necessary originals of the following documents to be recorded to the Recording Department. Items needed prior to forwarding to the Recording Department include the following:

- a. Resolution to set Public Hearing Date
- b. Proof of Publication of Notice of Public Hearing
- c. Resolution to Vacate
- d. Proof of Publication of Notice of Adoption of Resolution
- e. Check made payable to Clerk of Courts for recording fee

The Engineering Department will forward the original documents to the Recording Department. Recording will distribute copies of recorded documents to the County Engineer's Office. The County Engineer's Office will send copies to the Petitioner of record.

Please Note: The same procedures are to be followed if vacating an actual road or alley.

Easement Vacate Request Step 1 Process Chart

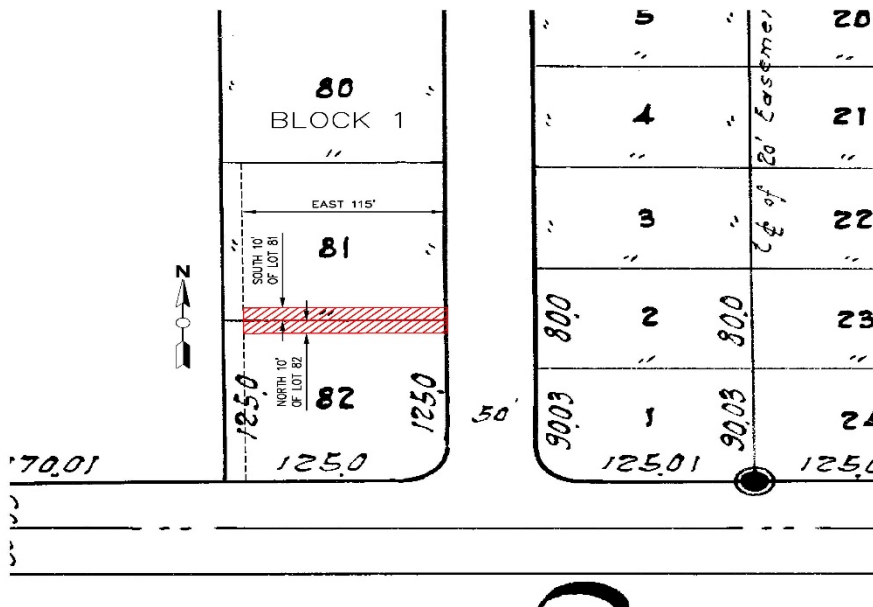


Below is a sample Legal Description to assist you in writing a Legal Description:

THE NORTH 10 FEET OF THE EAST 115 FEET OF LOT 82, BLOCK 1 AND THE SOUTH 10 FEET OF THE EAST 115 FEET OF LOT 81, BLOCK 1, ALL IN PLACID LAKES SECTION NINETEEN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 9, PAGE 14 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF HIGHLANDS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

The area to be vacated is described first (THE NORTH 10 FEET OF THE EAST 115 FEET OF) followed by the Legal Description for the property where the Easement is located (LOT 82, BLOCK 1 AND THE SOUTH 10 FEET OF THE EAST 115 FEET OF LOT 81, BLOCK1, ALL IN PLACID LAKES SECTION NINETEEN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 9, PAGE 14 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF HIGHLANDS COUNTY, FLORIDA.).

This diagram shows the area being described in the Legal Description above:



The Legal Description for the property where the Easement is located can be found on your Warranty Deed, if you do not have a copy of your Deed you can obtain a copy from the Clerk of Court. You could also get a Legal Description of your property from the Property Appraisers Office.
